1500 m night (June 22nd), the top combined places of male or female competitors at both races will be eligible for cash prizing of \$750, \$250

respectively for 1st and 2nd places.

and to parents, friends, and coaches especially at the meet site.

Protests: All protests must be made as outlined in IAAF rule 146. In all cases, protests

must be filed within 30 minutes of the official announcement or release of the results. If no protest is received within the above-mentioned time limit the result as released will stand. If a protest changes a result, 30 minutes will be allowed following the announcement or release of the decision for appeals to be brought forward. The decision of the referee may be appealed to the Jury of Appeal whose decision is final. Cost \$25.00 to be returned if

the protest is upheld.
